The City of Greenland recently purchased 47 acres with over 2,000 feet of frontage on the West Fork of the White River near 520 S. Main Avenue on the east side of U.S. Highway 71. The city proposes to convert the property into a natural area park and would like your input for the park Master Plan. Natural area parks are undeveloped or reclaimed lands that are open to the public and left largely undisturbed and managed for their ecological value (i.e., streams, forests). While they may have trails and occasional benches, they are typically not developed for any recreation activities beyond walking, running, and cycling. Natural area parks do not typically include items such as water features, swimming pools, baseball fields, tennis courts, and playgrounds.

The city is also accepting ideas for naming the park. Consideration will be given to historical, geographical, and social/cultural context or notable persons who have contributed to the community's history.
