ORDINANCE NO. 192

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL THE CITY OF GREENLAND ORDINANCE NUMBER 105, SECTIONS ONE AND TWO (1 & 2) OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 72 AND SECTIONS ONE AND TWO (1 & 2) OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 160

WHEREAS, the City of Greenland, Arkansas, has over the years, enacted Ordinance Number 72, Ordinance Number 105 and Ordinance Number 160 adopting procedures for the purchase, sale or exchange of property by the City;

WHEREAS, these are, in the latest form, found at Sections 3.04.01 and 3.04.02 of the Greenland Municipal Code;

WHEREAS, since the adoption of Ordinances 72,105 and 160, the Arkansas Supreme Court has decided the case of <u>Burke vs. Elmore</u> which casts doubt on the legality of the powers extended to the Mayor by those Ordinances.

WHEREAS, the City Council believes it is prudent to avoid any question of financial responsibility promptly.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GREENLAND CITY COUNCIL,
THAT:

SECTION 1: Effective with the passage of this Ordinance, Ordinance Number 105 is repealed in full, Sections One and Two (1 & 2) of Ordinance Number 72 are repealed, and Sections One and Two (1 & 2) of Ordinance Number 160 are repealed as are Sections 3.04.01 and 3.04.02 of the Greenland Municipal Code.

SECTION 2: That all other ordinances, laws and parts of Ordinances Number 72 and 160
