ORDINANCE 33

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION OF THE ESTIMATED COSTS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SEWER SYSTEM IN GREENLAND SEWER DISTRICT NUMBER ONE

WHEREAS, a majority in value of the property holders
owning property adjoining the locality to be affected and situated
in Greenland Sewer District No. 1 organized for the purpose of constructing
a sewer system have petitioned the governing body of the city of Greenland
for the construction of said improvement, and that the cost thereof shall
be assessed upon the real property of said district according to the benefits
received; and

WHEREAS, said benefits recieved by each and every block, lot and parcel of real property situated in said district equals or exceeds the local assessment thereon; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of said improvement is 511,500

Dollars:

Therefore, it is now ordained by the governing body of the city of Greenland, that said several blocks, lots and parcels of real property in said district be assessed according to the assessment list for said improvement district as the same now remains in the office of the recorder, and that 25 per centum of the assessment of each of said blocks, lots and parcels shall be collected by the County Collector on or before the 1st day of April 1976, and 75 per centum of the assessment shall be collected with the first installment of general taxes becoming due more than five (5) months thereafter and annually thereafter with the first installment of general taxes until the whole of said local assessment shall be paid.
