ORDINANCE NO. 52

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE SALE OR USE OF FIREWORKS WITHIN THE CITY OF GREENLAND, ARKANSAS, REQUIRING PERMITS FOR PUBLIC DISPLAYS, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENLAND, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to offer for sale, expose for sale, sell at retail, or use or explode any fireworks within the corporate limits of the City of Greenland, Arkansas.

Section 2. The City Council may upon the application of three or more adult individuals make an exception to the prohibition in Section 1 by issuing a Public Display Permit Application for a Public Display Permit shall be filed with the City Recorder at least 15 days in advance of the date of the display and shall state the name and address of the applicants and the date, time and place of the display. Upon determination that the display is of such a character and so located as not to be hazardous to property or to endanger any person, the City Council shall issue a Public Display Permit. The use of fireworks shall be lawful only for the purpose stated in the permit

Section 3. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined in any sum not exceeding One Hundred Dollars (\$100 and be confined in the County Jail not exceeding 30 days.
