AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR AND CITY RECORDER OF THE CITY OF GREENLAND, ARKANSAS, TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF ARKANSAS TO OBTAIN INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE FEDERAL SOCIAL SECURITY ACT: AUTHORIZING DEDUCTIONS FROM EMPLOYEES' WAGES; APPROPRIATING THE CITY'S PORTION OF THE TAX AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF GREENLAND, ARKANSAS.

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and City Recorder of the City of Greenland, Arkansas, are hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with the State of Arkansas for the purpose of obtaining insurance coverage for the employees of the City under the terms and provisions of the Federal Social Security Act.

SECTION 2. That commencing April 1, 1978, each employee's insurance contribution shall be deducted from his salary check in accordance with the terms and provisions of the said Social Security Act.

SECTION 3. That commencing April 1, 1978, there is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the City of Greenland, Arkansas, the sums of money necessary to pay the City's share of the insurance tax in accordance with the terms and provisions of the said Social Security Act

SECTION 4. All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed, and unless the provisions of this ordinance are placed into effect at once, the health, and safety of the citizens of the City will be adversely affected, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
