ORDINANCE NO. 59

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING BUILDING LOT SIZE AND SETBACK FROM STREETS AND PROPERTY LINES AND PROVIDING MINIMUM UNDERFLOOR CLEARANCE IN THE CITY OF GREENLAND, ARKANSAS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENLAND, ARKANSAS, that:

Section 1. Residential buildings proposed to be located on any lot in the City of Greenland shall comply with the following minimum setbacks:

- a. Twenty-five 25 feet from the right-of-way line of any adjacent city street or road.
  - b. Seven (7) feet from any adjoining property line

Section 2. Any building which is constructed to provide access under the floor for the installation of sewer, water and other utility service shall have a minimum of twenty-four (24) inches clearance frum the underside of the floor to the highest point of ground surface

Section 3. The minimum lot size for construction of single-family dwellings shall be one hundred (100) feet by one hundred fifty (150) feet, except that corner lots shall be a minimum of one hundred twenty-five (125) feet by one hundred fifty (150) feet.

Section 4. No building permit shall be issued except upon a written application showing compliance with this ordinance.
