ORDINANCE NO. 99

AN ORDINANCE DIVIDING THE CITY OF GREENLAND INTO FOUR WARDS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES IN THE CITY OF GREENLAND, ARKANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENLAND, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Greenland pursuant to Arkansas Statutes 19-1113 finds that the citizens of Greenland will best be served by division of the City into Four Wards for the purpose of electing aldermen to the City Council.

SECTION 2. The Council hereby divides the City into Wards 1, 2, 3, and 4. The boundaries of the Wards are as shown on the attached map and boundary description

SECTION 3. At the next General Election and at each General Election thereafter the Citizens of Greenland will elect two Aldermen from each Ward. Each candidate must be a resident of the Ward to be represented and served as Alderman. Alderman will be elected at large, by majority vote of the electors voting for that office.
