ORDINANCE NO. 175

AN ORDINANCE TO RENAME A CERTAIN STREET AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY TO EXIST AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the City of Greenland and one or more nearby cities
have streets bearing the same or a similar name of Dixon Street;
and,

WHEREAS, identically named/sounding streets has caused
significant confusion and resultant delays and problems concerning
delivery of mail and other deliveries; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Council of Greenland, Arkansas, does
desire to rename Dixon street as it is currently situated in
Greenland, Arkansas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF GREENLAND, ARKANSAS

Section 1: That the street in Greenland, Arkansas,
formerly known as Dixon Street which begins on the west side of
U.S. Highway 71 on the East and runs to the West for a distance of
1320 feet, shall hereafter be known as Roadrunner Lane for all
intents and purpose; the address numbering shall remain as
formerly.

Section 2: It is further determined and ordained by the
City Council of Greenland, Arkansas, that an emergency exists;
immediate passage and implementation of this Ordinance is necessary
for the protection, benefit and welfare of numerous citizens of
Greenland, Arkansas, and therefore, this Ordinance shall be
