

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE COLLECTION OF WARRANT SERVICE FEES BY THE GREENLAND POLICE DEPARTMENT AND CREATING A WARRANTS SERVICE FUND.**

WHEREAS that the City Council of the City of Greenland, Arkansas, has determined that additional costs are incurred by the City as a result of having to serve warrants from the city court and


WHEREAS Arkansas law allows Police Departments to charge the same fee for service of warrants as Sheriff's are authorized to collect, it is prudent to enact enabling legislation to authorize the Greenland Police Department to collect a fee for the service of warrants as so authorized.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENLAND, ARKANSAS:

**WARRANT SERVICE FEES:**

For each warrant for the City Court of Greenland, Arkansas, served on a Defendant appearing before said Court, there shall be collected from each such Defendant upon each plea of guilty, nolo contendere, forfeiture of bond or determination of guilt for misdemeanors or traffic violations in the City Court the sum of Fifty dollars (\$50.00), which sum shall be placed in a separate fund called the WARRANTS SERVICE FUND to be used by the City to defray the expenses of the service of warrants issued by the City Court of Greenland, Arkansas.
