

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A CITY COURT
IN GREENLAND, ARKANSAS

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Greenland, Arkansas, a City of the Second Class, has within the limits of the same, all the jurisdiction and power of a Justice of the Peace in all matters civil and criminal arising under the laws of this state,

WHEREAS, the Mayor has exclusive jurisdiction of all prosecutions of violations of any ordinance of the City, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor may designate at such times as he shall choose to do so any qualified elector of the City or any attorney licensed in the State of Arkansas who resides in Washington County to sit in the Mayor's stead as Judge of the Court

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF GREENLAND, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. There is hereby established a Mayor's Court within the City of Greenland. The Mayor's Court herein established shall be known and referred to as the Greenland City Court, or City Court

Section 2. The City Court shall be in regular session at 2:00 p.m. on the first and third Wednesday of each month, and at such other times as may be required.


Section 3. The Mayor shall appoint a qualified elector or an attorney resident in Washington County to serve as Judge of the City Court. Said Judge is to receive compensation in the amount of thirty dollars (\$30) per day for each day court is in session.

Section 4. All fines and costs ordered by the Court shall be collected by the City police officer. Said officer shall issue proper receipt for all money collected and shall account for

same to the City Treasurer. The City police officer shall be bonded for not less than fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000).

Section 5. The City Treasurer shall make monthly reports to the City Council on the status of funds received and disbursed for the City Court. The Treasurer shall allocate and pay Court costs as provided by law.
