

ORDINANCE NO. 304

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 7.28, SECTION 7.28.01 OF TITLE 7 OF THE GREENLAND MUNICIPAL CODE, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY TO EXIST, AND FOR OTHER RELATED PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, previous exceptions to the prohibition against use of fireworks allowed their use as early as 6:00 A.M. on certain days;

WHEREAS, previous exception to the prohibition against use of fireworks did not include provision for use at New Years.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF GREENLAND, ARKANSAS, That

Section 1: From and after the effective date of this Ordinance Section 7.28.01 of Chapter 7.28 of Title 7 of the Greenland Municipal Code shall read as follows:

“7.28.01 Use. It shall be unlawful for any person to ignite, start, shoot or set fire to any firecracker, rocket, roman candle, or any other firework within the corporate limits of the City except

- During the hours of 12:00 P.M. (NOON) to 12:00 A.M. (MIDNIGHT) on July 1, July 2, July 3 and July 4 of each year; or
- During the hours of 12:00 P.M. (NOON) on December 31 of each year to 1:00 A.M. on January 1 of the following year.”

Section 2: This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by the Council to preserve the peace, safety and quiet of the City as the 4th of July holiday approaches, therefore an emergency is hereby declared and this ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage and approval.
