ORDINANCE NO. 344

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING GREENLAND MUNICIPAL CODE TITLE 14, CHAPTER 14.04, SECTION 14.04.06; AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the City of Greenland previously rezoned certain residential areas as commercial zones, in anticipation of future growth; however, the City hasn't yet realized the anticipated commercial growth; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has recommended changes to Paragraph F of Section 14.04.06 to allow the rebuilding of non-conforming structures until such time as the City needs to revisit this planning matter.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF GREENLAND, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. That the Greenland Municipal Code, Greenland, Arkansas, bearing the date of February 2019 is hereby amended by deleting the language contained in the body of <u>Paragraph F. Damage and destruction</u> of Section 14.04.06, and replacing it with the following language:

F. <u>Damage and destruction</u>

- 1. Involuntary damage to or destruction of a nonconforming structure or a structure containing a non-confirming use (from fire, winds or other calamity) shall permit the owner to rebuild, reconstruct or restore the structure on the same footprint of the original structure plus any addition or expansion that is allowed by the underlying zoning district. Such reconstruction is permitted as long as it begins within eighteen (18) months of the loss and complies with all other applicable zoning, development and building codes.
- 2. Failure to exercise the options herein provided within the time specified shall be considered a voluntary abandonment and structure(s) may be rebuilt and used thereafter only for a conforming use and in compliance with provisions of the district in which it is located. As provided in 14.04.05, previously platted non-conforming lots may be utilized. (Ord. No. 277, Sec. 6.).
- 3. Repairs to nonconforming structures or portions thereof are permitted, so long as the nonconforming portion of the structure is not enlarged in volume, area, or footprint.

SECTION 2. REPEALER: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY: If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole, or any part or provision, other than the part so decided to be invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE: The Council believes an immediate amendment is necessary to allow for expedient rebuilding and to prevent delay to the owner of a non-conforming structure; therefore, it is viewed that an immediate solution is necessary, thereby creating an emergency. It is hereby declared that based on the conditions set forth herein, an emergency exists, and this Ordinance, being necessary for the immediate protection of the health, welfare and safety of the citizens of Greenland, Arkansas, shall be in effect immediately upon its passage, approval and publication.
