

ORDINANCE NO. 105

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE #72 AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURE FOR PURCHASING, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENLAND, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. That section 1 of ordinance #72 is hereby amended so that after amendment said section shall read as follows:  
The Mayor, or his duly authorized representative, shall have exclusive power and responsibility to make purchases of all supplies, apparatus, equipment, materials and other things requisite for public purposes for the City of Greenland, and to make all necessary contracts for work or labor to be done, or material or other necessary things to be furnished for the benefit of the city without receiving bids, where the amount of the expenditure for any purpose or contract does not exceed the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00).

Section 2. That section 2 of ordinance #72 shall be amended so that after amendment said section shall read as follows:  
Where the amount of expenditure for any purchase or contract exceeds the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00), the Mayor, or his duly authorized representative, shall invite competitive bids thereon by legal advertisement in any local newspaper. Bids received pursuant to said advertisement shall be opened and read on the date set for receiving said bids, in the presence of the Mayor, or his duly authorized representative. The contract shall be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder; provided, however, the Mayor, or his duly authorized representative, may reject any and all bids received.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and that it is in the best interest of the City of Greenland, Arkansas that this ordinance be in effect from the date of passage hereof.
