

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 2, 3, 4 AND 8 OF ORDINANCE NO. 64 OF THE CITY OF GREENLAND, ARKANSAS IN REGARD TO EXCAVATION OF PUBLIC STREETS

WHEREAS, the Greenland City Council on February 1, 1980, passed Ordinance No. 64 to provide for orderly and proper procedures to cut a city street, repair same and other matters relating thereto; and,

WHEREAS, the Greenland City Council on June 15, 1981, passed Ordinance No. 71 to provide standards for the restoration of public streets after a street cut; and,

WHEREAS, as a result of changes which occurred since Ordinance No. 64 was enacted, Sections 2, 3, 4, and 8 thereof need to be amended to increase financial matters and to enhance safety procedures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF GREENLAND, ARKANSAS, THAT:

Section 1: After the effective date of this Ordinance, the fee referred to in Section 2 of Ordinance No. 64 shall be \$25.00 rather than \$5.00.

Section 2: After the effective date of this Ordinance, the cash bond amount referred to in Section 3 of Ordinance No. 64 shall be \$300.00 rather than \$100.00

Section 3: After the effective date of this Ordinance, the maximum fine for violation of Ordinance No. 64 for each offense referred to in Section 8 of Ordinance No. 64 shall be \$100.00 rather than \$50.00.

Section 4: After the effective date of this Ordinance, Section 4 of Ordinance No. 64 shall read


as follows:

“The permittee shall place and maintain around the excavation adequate guards, fencing, warning signs (bilingual), lights and other devices as shall be necessary to give warning to anyone using the road/street, sidewalks and the affected area.”

Section 5: In all other respects, and except as specifically provided herein or in Ordinance No

71, Ordinance No. 64 is hereby ratified and confirmed.
