

ORDINANCE NO. 197

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE HIRING OF PROFESSIONAL SERVICES FOR PLANNED IMPROVEMENTS ON LETITIA STREET AND OTHER PROJECTS, AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY TO EXIST

WHEREAS, the Greenland City Council has determined that improvements need to be made to Letitia Street as well as other streets and/or areas of the City.

WHEREAS, the Council believes it is in the best interest of the City and its citizens if professional engineering services are obtained in the planning and execution of these projects.

WHEREAS, the Council has sought and received information from a number of engineering firms to enable the Council to make an informed decision regarding the hiring of an engineer to provide these professional services.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GREENLAND CITY COUNCIL:

SECTION 1: That the firm of McClelland Consulting Engineers, Inc. seems best qualified to provide engineering services to the City of Greenland on the anticipated projects relating to Letitia Street and Allen Street.


SECTION 2: That the Mayor and Recorder/Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a letter of engagement or other agreement to obtain for the City engineering services from McClelland Consulting Engineers, Inc.

SECTION 3: That the firm shall be compensated and paid in accordance with the agreements entered into with respect to each project which shall be on the basis of percentage of project costs not to exceed 10% of such costs.

SECTION 4: BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY


OF GREENLAND, THAT one or more of these projects is necessary to provide basic services to residents in these areas and therefore, an emergency exists, immediate passage and implementation of this Ordinance is necessary for the efficient administration of City business and to preserve the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Greenland, Arkansas, and therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
