

ORDINANCE NO. 242

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 156 AND SETTING COMPENSATION FOR THE HOLDER OF THE OFFICE REORDER-TREASURER AND THE COURT CLERK FOR ATTENDANCE AT COUNCIL MEETINGS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY TO EXIST; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 156, passed in 1995 set compensation for the person holding the office of Recorder/Treasurer for the City of Greenland for attending the regular monthly City Council meetings at \$25.00 per month.

WHEREAS, the Court Clerk or his/her designee has also been compensated for attendance at the regular monthly meeting of the City Council at the rate of \$25.00 per month.

WHEREAS, with the passage of time and expansion of duties and responsibilities related to council meetings for these office holders the compensation should be increased.

WHEREAS, the City Council members periodically review compensation for themselves and others to insure that the rates are fair and equitable.

WHEREAS, it is unduly burdensome and complicated to raise/adjust compensation by ordinance,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF GREENLAND, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: Effective January 1, 2006, the rate of compensation for the holder of the office of Recorder/Treasurer in Greenland, Arkansas, and the Clerk of the Greenland City Court shall each receive compensation for their attendance at the regular monthly meetings of the City Council, at the rate established for the members of the Council.


SECTION 2: That such future adjustments shall not require passage of an ordinance or written resolution but shall be duly recorded in the minutes of such meeting.

SECTION 3: That the compensation received for attendance of said meeting will be in addition to any and all other salaries received by the holder of the office of Greenland Recorder/Treasurer and Clerk of the Greenland City Court

SECTION 4: That Ordinance No. 156 along with any other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5: An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance being necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Greenland, Arkansas, shall be in full-force and effect from the date of its passage and approval.
