

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH IN THE CITY OF GREENLAND A
POLICE DEPARTMENT AND TO PROVIDE FOR ITS OPERATION
AND SUPERVISION

There is hereby established in the City of Greenland, Arkansas, a police department which shall be characterized by the following:

ONE: Have a Chief of Police appointed by the Mayor with approval of the City Council.

Employ such deputies as the City Council shall approve.

THREE: Exercise all the powers and perform all the duties previously the responsibility of the City Marshall as prescribed in Ark. Stat. 19-1104.

FOUR: Be responsible to the Police Commission for the care and proper use of the city-owned vehicles and equipment assigned to the department.

The Mayor shall, from time to time, appoint three (3) members of the Council who will serve as the Police Commission. The Police Commission shall oversee the performance of police duties except those under direction of the City Court and shall advise and inform the Council of the status, requirements and performance of the Police Department.

The Chief of Police of the City of Greenland shall maintain a close working relationship with the County Sheriff's Department to the end that the police function of the City of Greenland will be most effectively performed and that the facilities and services of the Sheriff's Department will be available to the City of Greenland. The Chief of Police is authorized to serve (if appointed) as a deputy to the County Sheriff

fees, awards and special payments to the Police Department or its members shall be deposited with the City Treasurer and credited to the City General Fund.

The Chief of Police shall be paid a salary of one hundred fifty dollars (\$150) per month. This amount shall be in addition to any salary paid by the County Sheriff.
