

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE OPERATION
AND SUPERVISION OF THE GREENLAND CITY
POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 43, the City of Greenland established a Police Department with the powers and duties previously the responsibility of the City Marshall as prescribed in Ark.Stats. 19-1104; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor is empowered to appoint the Chief of Police and Deputies subject to the approval of the City Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENLAND, that:

Section 1. Paragraph 4 of Ordinance No. 43, An Ordinance to Establish in the City of Greenland a Police Department and to Provide for its Operation and Supervision, is hereby repealed

Section 2. The Mayor of the City of Greenland shall be responsible for the administrative supervision of the Police Department and shall oversee the performance of police duties except those under direction of the City Court and shall advise and inform the Council of the status, requirements and performance of the Police Department

Section 3. The Chief of Police of the City of Greenland shall maintain a close working relationship with the County Sheriff's Department to the end that the police function of the City of Greenland will be most effectively performed and that the facilities and services of the Sheriff's Department will be available to the City of Greenland.

Section 4. The Chief of Police shall be responsible for the care and proper use of the City owned vehicles and equipment assigned to the Police Department.

Section 5. The Chief of Police shall be responsible that all fees, awards, and special payments to the Police Department or its members shall be deposited with the City Treasurer for credit to the City General Fund.

Section 6. The Mayor shall appoint three (3) members of the Council who will serve as the Police Commission with the duties to evaluate the performance of the Police Department, and to advise and inform the Council of the status, requirements, and performance of the Police Department.
