

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A CITY PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GREENLAND, ARKANSAS

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENLAND, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. There is hereby created a commission of the City of Greenland, Arkansas, to be known as the "City Planning Commission," which said commission shall consist of five (5) members who shall serve without compensation and of whom not more than one-third may hold any other municipal office or appointment.

Section 2. The City Planning Commission shall have all the duties and functions as pertaining to planning commission as conferred upon the City for planning as provided by Act 186 of the Acts of Arkansas 1957.

Section 3. The members of the City Planning Commission shall be named and appointed by the Mayor and his appointments will be valid and effective upon confirmation by the City Council.

Section 4. The terms of the members of the City Planning Commission shall be for four (4) years. As vacancies occur, from whatever cause other than expiration of terms, such vacancies shall be filled in the manner provided in Section 3. hereinabove, and such appointees shall hold office until expiration of the term which they were appointed to fill. All members of the Commission whose terms may expire shall continue to serve until their successors in office have been appointed and confirmed.

Section 5. Emergency clause. This Ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, comfort, convenience, morals, safety and welfare of the City of Greenland, an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of its adoption.
